Travel Insurance, optional destination experiences, on board spending of a personal nature i.e. drinks, gifts, shopping, laundry, any visa and health certificate or testing charges that may apply and crew gratuities.

Gratuities:

Ambassador Cruise Line operate an automatic system whereby an amount of £7.00 per person per night (this amount reduces to £6.00 per person for cruises of 16 nights or more in duration) is automatically added to your on board account. This also includes service charges for drinks. All monies are collated so a proportion goes to each crew member who helps to make your cruise special. This is not only distributed to your cabin steward and your waiter/bar attendant, but also between the hidden stars behind the scenes, such as laundry operatives and kitchen staff who you may never get to meet in person.




